B2H Medicaid Waiver Program Training for Local Department of Social Services Staff Training #2

Administrators, supervisors and caseworkers from the LDSS or the Division of Juvenile Justice and Opportunities for Youth (DJJOY) who attend this **full** day training session will demonstrate an understanding of:

- The structure, eligibility, and guidelines of the B2H Medicaid Waiver Program;
- the role and responsibilities of LDSS and DJJOY within the B2H Medicaid Waiver Program; and
- the identification of children and youth who qualify for the B2H Medicaid Waiver Program.

B2H Medicaid Waiver Program Training for Health Care Integration Agency and Waiver Service Provider Administrative Staff Training #3

Administrators from Health Care Integration Agencies (HCIAs) and Waiver Service Provider Agencies (WSPs) who attend this **full** day training session will demonstrate an understanding of:

- The structure, eligibility, and guidelines of the B2H Medicaid Waiver Program;
- the role and responsibilities of the HCIAs and the WSPs;
- the documentation and billing requirements of the B2H Medicaid Waiver Program; and
- the quality management requirements of the B2H Medicaid Waiver Program.

B2H Medicaid Waiver Program Training for Health Care Integrators and Health Care Integrator Supervisors Training #4

Health Care Integrators (HCIs) and HCI Supervisors who attend this 3 day training session will demonstrate an understanding of:

- The structure, eligibility, and guidelines of the B2H Medicaid Waiver Program;
- the identification of children and youth who qualify for the B2H Medicaid Waiver Program;
- the role and responsibilities of the HCIAs, HCI and the WSPs;
- the services of the B2H Medicaid Waiver Program; and
- the documentation, billing and quality management requirements for the B2H Medicaid Waiver Program.

Training #4 is required for all HCI's within 6 months of providing B2H Medicaid Waiver Services. Training #4 is also required for all HCI Supervisors prior to providing supervision for B2H Medicaid Waiver Services.

B2H Medicaid Waiver Program Training for Waiver Service Providers Training #5

This 3 day series of workshops will include sessions that fulfill training requirements for WSPs and are listed below:

Working in a Family's Home	Parenting Skills
Crisis Respite, Planned Respite, Safety Planning	Special Needs Community Advocacy & Support
Job Readiness and Supported Employment	

Training #5 is required for all HCI's and WSP's within 6 months of providing B2H Medicaid Waiver Services.
